

Visitors will also have the opportunity to explore Ambassador Panels, which provide personal stories of the original group members, and *The Prelude*, which introduces the annual Jubilee Day at Fisk University. The exhibit will also feature *Fast Forwards*, which connect thematic chapters through evocative images and phrases, and *The Coda*, where the exhibition culminates in a powerful section that brings their journey full circle.

This exhibit not only honors the Fisk Jubilee Singers' historic contributions but also emphasizes their lasting influence on American music and culture. It celebrates their work as pioneers who used music as a tool for resilience, empowerment, and social change.
